ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14(1)

Temporary Prohibition of Vehicular Traffic, Suspension of One-Way Working and Temporary Waiting and Loading Restrictions

Shorts Road

- 1. The Council of the London Borough of Sutton with the agreement of Transport for London hereby gives notice to remove a tower crane from a new development on the corner of Carshalton Road and Shorts Road, Carshalton it intends to make a Temporary Order the effect of which is summarised in paragraph 3 below.
- 2. The Order will come into effect on Saturday 23 June 2012 with the works expected to take 1 day to complete. However, the Order will remain in force for 18 months to be re-introduced should further works be required.
- 3. When the works are taking place and the appropriate traffic signs are being displayed the Order will temporarily in Shorts Road between its junctions with Alma Road and Carshalton Road:-
 - (a) prohibit all vehicular traffic;
 - (b) suspend the one-way working; and
 - (c) introduce waiting restrictions 'no waiting' and loading restrictions 'no loading / unloading' at any time.
- 4. Alternative routes for vehicular traffic will be suitably signed.
- 5. Vehicular access to premises adjacent to the prohibited length of Shorts Road will be maintained via Alma Road insofar as access is reasonably practicable without interference with the said works.
- 6. Any vehicle that is in contravention of the permanent waiting and loading restrictions or of the temporary restrictions at a time when these restrictions apply will be removed to an alternative location in accordance with the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
- 7. The prohibitions specified above apply only during such times and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs prescribed by the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002.
